- Focus on education about finance, to help tackle fears of rising expense
- Recognise that *Access* is not just about Cambridge, and make provision for including more students thinking of a University education in the *Target* scheme
- Focus on creating a more informal dialogue between potential applicants and volunteers, and to this end create a scheme of direct email communication whereby queries can be answered
