2. Apologies

3. Officers reports: President
  - The TV for the bar has been bought.
  - There is an NUS demonstration on 4/11/08 against Top up fees increasing.
4. Officers reports: Vice-president

  - At the recent finance committee meeting, it was discovered that only 10% of the costs of the renovations to Howard Court was provided by the Howard fund. This was £66,000. This means that around £600,000 was spent by college on the project. This is contrary to what D Chapman stated on the JCR website over the summer, and so he intends to make this apology at the next JCR open Meeting. D Chapman advised the finance committee that this would greatly anger much of the JCR.
